He's a tall guy with the red beard and funny hat with the light in it. And when the music starts, he's in the middle, adding to the chorus and probably knowing all the lines. Mike is also a writer of songs and recitations. He'll make you laugh, cry...and think, all the while entertaining us long into an evening of music.
